(1) School based Learning activities related to Citizenship and Social Development curriculum

Local study tour to Sha Tau Kok	F.4 students	\$49640	The tour allows F4 students to taste the experience of field study. It also allows students to extend their learning beyond the classroom, and reinforce their understanding and learning of the history of Hong Kong. (2) Subsidising students to participate in cross-curricular activities related to Citizenship and Social Development curriculum

Interschool Mock Trial and Mooting Competition	F.4-5 students	\$2700	All participants agreed that the competition was able to enhance their generic skills, including critical thinking, communication and collaboration skills, problem solving skills and self-management skills. In addition, the competition has also deepened students' understanding and valuation of law-abidingness.	May continue and subject to the availability of human resources.

(3) Subsidising students and/or teachers to participate in Mainland study tours

Miscellaneous expenses related to the mainland study tour	F.5 students	\$2018	The 2022-2023 C&SD Mainland Study Tour was fully funded by the Education Bureau. The school has used the funding to support the miscellaneous expenses related to the tour, such as first-aid kits and SIM cards for teachers' communication. In addition, the school has also assigned one extra teacher to join the tour better cater for the needs of students.	The department will join two-day tour next year and will join tours that allows more interactions with the locals.

			Teachers and students generally find that their experience of the one-day tour was superficial. Teachers find that visiting museums was not effective in cultivating students' curiosity in the subject.

It has been helpful for teachers to prepare for the lesson. However, only a small portion of students really has the capacity to go through the materials.	Since only a small portion of students read through the materials regularly, the department will not subscribe the magazine for students in the coming academic year.
Subscription of publishers teaching resources bank	C&SD Teachers	\$1504	Subscription of the service has been useful for the teachers in the department to prepare for learning and teaching materials. The cartoon and data provided in the resources bank also help teachers to prepare for class activities.	Will continue to subscribe the resources bank.
